



## **Quorum: predicting Congressional efficiency**


### Company



### **User Insight/Need**

Understanding linkages between Congress members' behavior and federal spending trends in their districts (e.g. committee membership, bi-partisanship voting etc')









## Thomson Reuters: finding unknown linkages


### Company



### User Insight/Need

Need consistent, single entity identifier across all public data sources to tie to companies effectively

### **Product**



A central repository of cross-references between Legal Entity Identifiers, DUNS and PermID





## Fannie Mae: pricing mortgages more accurately

### Company



### User Insight/Need

Federal spending data, as an indicator of overall investment in an area, may inform mortgage pricing model

### **Product**

Price<sub>t</sub> = 
$$P(X_t, t, USAspending)$$















Insight

Businesses want actionable information that can help them plan

#### **Near-Term Immediate Actions**

- Add fields to the data schema to tie expenditure to agency plans:
  - OMB Exhibit 300s
  - GSA Schedule
  - Line-items from budget

### Long Term Vision

- Create single platform for:
  - Past expenditures
  - Forward-looking opportunities







## Offer analyses and visualizations in addition to raw data

Insight

Businesses and data firms want insights and second-order takeaways beyond the raw data

#### **Near Term Immediate Actions**

- Add filters for industry, product, certification and sub-contracting
- Easier visualization of time-series data
- Macro-level summaries

### **Long Term Vision**

Create data schema for grantees and contractors





## Cross-platform data usage via single identifier

Insight

Data firms need open source, standardized entity identifiers to enhance interoperability across data and to show business categorizations

#### **Near Term Immediate Actions**

- Add Legal Entity Identifier to Treasury's financial data
  - May still include DUNS
- Thomson Reuters collaboration on cross-referencing PermID

### **Long Term Vision**

• Roll-out Legal Entity Identifier as default identifier across all government agencies
